At the same time they had good control over cost, production scheduling etc., to make the projects viable. They are also known for fulfilling their commitment to various sections of the film industry and the people they deal with. That is one of the main reasons for their long standing reputation in the industry as producers. Their contribution to the then thriving industry was significant. Unfortunately producers of such calibre are a vanishing tribe now.

We are proud, that both these veterans always chose Prasad Film Laboratories and Prasad Group Companies for the post production work. The Management and the employees of Prasad are grateful to these two greats who have always appreciated quality and patronized Prasad. We deeply mourn the sad demise of these two personalities who were not only great producers but also great human beings, always kind and warm.

YOUNG ENTREPRENEUR AWARDEES VISIT PRASAD

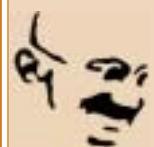

ARENA MULTIMEDIA STUDENTS VISIT PRASAD



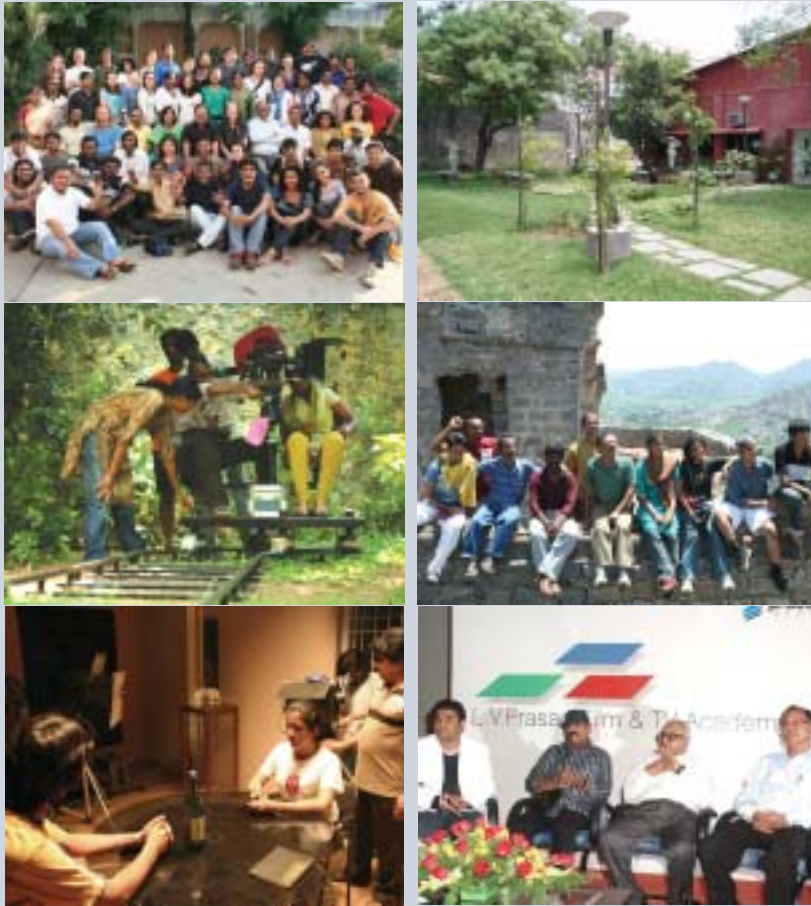

It all began with the IFFI in Goa where one of our cinematography students' works was selected for the Panorama. Abhyuday Khaitan's film *'The Shop that sold everything'* was screened and came in for a lot of praise. Our own Chennai International Film Festival next, screened all our diploma films of 2008 as part of their programme and this was reported in all the media.

Soon on its heels came this year's Berlin International Film Festival where Abhyuday was invited again and along with him the Berlinale also invited our direction student R S Prasanna to be a member. They had some very valuable discussions with fellow filmmakers from all over the world. Another student film called *'Janmantharam'* by Nishant Ravindran was screened at the Colombo International Film Festival. In the beginning of March a very reputed Student film portal called Reelshow International declared our Academy as among the top ten film schools in the world. And in the most recent edition they have voted Prasanna's diploma film *'Penn Vesham'* as the best student film for this quarter. Incidentally this film was also given the gold medal by our own august jury during the diploma screenings last August.

Last month the Sischutke film festival in Potsdam, Germany screened direction student Rohin's diploma film *'Nanba'* in the competition section and Alok Naik's film *'Mallika'* in the information section. Both of them were invited to the festival and their films were appreciated immensely. The Lucknow Film Festival held last month showed the student films of Abhilasha and Rohin. All of this proves that there is going to be a growing market for short films and with the growing popularity of Direct-To-Home television, I am sure, audiences in the future will be calling in for short films quite like the way they are downloading mobile ring tones! We must realize that cinema as an art form can never fade out. It will only change its shape to suit the requirements of the audience.

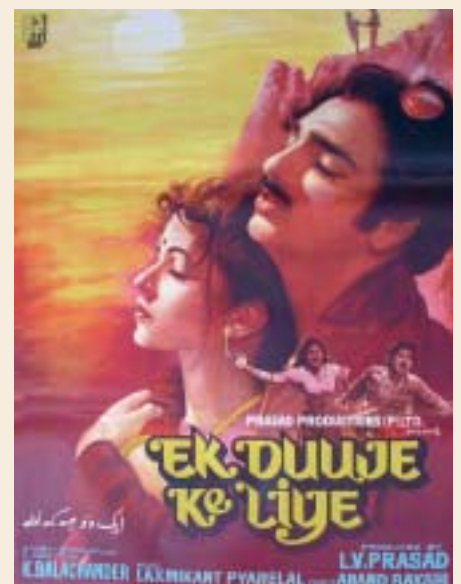

COMMON SYMPTOMS OF HEART ATTACK.. LET'S BE CAREFUL AND BE AWARE

- You should know that not every heart attack symptom is the left arm hurting.
- Be aware of intense pain in the jaw line.
- You may never have the first chest pain during the course of a heart attack.
- Nausea and intense sweating are also common symptoms.
- 60% of people who have a heart attack while they are asleep do not wake up. Pain in the jaw can wake you from a sound sleep.



FIRST AID

- Have the person sit down, rest, and try to keep calm.
- Loosen any tight clothing.
- Ask if the person takes any chest pain medication for a known heart condition and help the person take the medication.
- Call for emergency medical help.
- If the person is unconscious and unresponsive, call emergency medical help, then begin Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR - combines rescue breathing and chest compressions. Rescue breathing provides oxygen to the person's lungs. Chest compressions keep oxygen-rich blood circulating until an effective heartbeat and breathing can be restored).



DO NOT

- Do NOT leave the person alone except to call for help, if necessary.
- Do NOT allow the person to deny the symptoms and convince you not to call for emergency help.
- Do NOT wait to see if the symptoms go away.
- Do NOT give the person anything by mouth unless a heart medication has been prescribed.
